## **ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS** FOR STACK RACK DISPENSING SYSTEM

Note: Do Not assemble STACK RACK unless it is at Room Temperature of at least 65°F

STACK RACK should be assembled as follows:

## The unassembled STACK RACK carton consists of the following items:

- For the 4 Shelf STACK RACK 4 plastic shelves and 16 plastic posts.
- One packet of 4 plastic end caps to be placed on the end fittings of top shelf once STACK RACK is fully assembled.
- Additional parts to make other STACK RACK configurations are available. See other side for wire basket installation instructions.

## 1) Place one of the plastic shelves on a flat surface with the smooth side facing up. Insert one post over each one of the top shelf sockets of the shelf then push down with a slight STOPPER twist until post is flush with shelf. Make sure each post is flush with shelf to assure proper balance. A slight amount of lubricant will help for a tight fitting post. 2) Keeping the "Stopper" (A) aligned the "Stopper" on the bottom shelf, place the next shelf, smooth side up so the 4 vertical posts, already assembled, slide into the bottom shelf sockets of this shelf. "Stoppers" should be aligned for proper inserting of plastic containers. 3) Simply apply downward pressure to each corner of the shelf to secure tight fit of the shelf. 4) The above assembly procedure should be repeated for the next section of posts and shelves until the STACK RACK is completely assembled. 5) On the bottom shelf, insert 10 3/4" posts, then stand STACK RACK upright to assure stability. 6) After completing assembly, use package of plastic end caps and place 4 end fittings on top shelf.
